**NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE**

Please take notice that Penobscot McCrum, LLC of PO Box 660, Mars Hill, Maine 04758 intends to file an application for Major Amendment of a Site Location of Development Act license with the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Maine DEP), pursuant to the provisions of 38 M.R.S.A. §§ 481 thru 490 on or about April 26, 2019. The development which is the subject of this application includes the construction of a potato processing facility along with a number of ancillary elements, including wastewater treatment and disposal.

A request for a public hearing or a request that the Board of Environmental Protection assume jurisdiction over this application must be received by the Department in writing, no later than 20 days after the application is found by the Department to be complete and is accepted for processing.

MAINE AIR EMISSIONS LICENSE**

Please take notice that Penobscot McCrum, LLC of PO Box 660, Mars Hill, Maine 04758 intends to file an application to amend an existing Air Emission License with the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Maine DEP), pursuant to the provisions of 38 M.R.S.A., Section 590 on or about April 26, 2019. The application is associated with improvements to a potato processing facility located off Parsons Street in Washburn, ME. According to Department regulations, interested parties must be publicly notified, written comments invited, and if justified, an opportunity for public hearing given. A request for a public hearing or for the Board of Environmental Protection to assume jurisdiction must be received by the Department, in writing, no later than 20 days after the application is accepted by the Department as complete for processing.

The application and supporting documentation will be available for review at the Bureau of Air Quality (BAQ) DEP offices in Augusta, (207) 287-7688, during normal working hours. **MAINE WASTE DISCHARGE LICENSE/MAINE POLLUTANT DISCHARGE**  
**ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT APPLICATION**

Please take note that, pursuant to 38 MRSA, Sections 413 and 414-A, Penobscot McCrum, LLC of PO Box 660, Mars Hill, Maine 04758 intends to file a waste discharge permit application with the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Maine DEP). The application is for the discharge via land application of 225,000 gallons per day of treated wastewater at the project site in Washburn, Maine.

The application will be filed on or about April 26, 2019 and will be available for public inspection at Maine DEP's Augusta office during normal business hours. A copy may also be seen at the municipal offices in Washburn, Maine.

A request for public hearing or request that the Board of Environmental Protection assume jurisdiction over this application must be received by the Maine DEP, in writing, no later than 20 days after the application is found acceptable for processing, or 30 days from the date of this notice, whichever is longer. Requests shall state the nature of the issue(s) to be raised. Unless otherwise provided by law, a hearing is discretionary and may be held if the Commissioner or the Board find significant public interest or there is conflicting technical information.

During the time specified above, persons wishing to receive copies of draft permits and supporting documents, when available, may request them from Maine DEP. Persons receiving a draft permit shall have 30 days in which to submit comments or to request a public hearing on the draft.

Public comment will be accepted until a final administrative action is taken to approve, approve with conditions or deny this application.
